Full Draw

SAN DIEGO, CA, August 8, 2005 – First and Second round matches have now been completed at the [2005 USTA Girls 16 National Championships](#) with no major upsets and several locals continuing in the draw. Matches continue on Tuesday, August 9 at 8 am with the final 64 players competing for the prestigious national championship trophy and the USTA Gold Ball Award for this age division.

The highest ranked local player, Natasha Makarova who is seeded #20, won her first round in decisive fashion with a 6-2, 6-0 win over Stefana Petrelli of Harrison, NY. Makarova's win sets up a home town battle with CoCo Vanderweghe who won her second match today over Adrienne Markison of Princeton, NJ 6-1, 6-1. San Diego's other seeded player, Rebecca Kwan (#30) also won her first round match today over Christy Core of Charlotte, NC 6-2, 6-0. Another local standout in Monday's matches was Kimberly Haynes who reached the third round by defeating Nadja Gilchrist of Rochester, NY 6-4, 6-3.

The only upsets today came with the lower seeded players and all of the top seeds have advanced as expected. This year's #1 seed, who also happens to be the 2004 finalist, Reka Zsilinszka won her match without losing a game. The only top 16 seed to fall today was Lauren Megale of Boise, ID who was defeated by Carolyn Mcveigh of New Canaan, CT 6-3, 6-3.

The 2005 USTA Girls 16 National Championships is in its 15th year in San Diego and 10th year to be held at the [George E. Barnes Family Junior Tennis Center](#) located at 4490 West Point Loma Boulevard on the corner of W Pt. Loma and Nimitz. Matches will continue through the week with the finals scheduled for 11:30 am Sunday, August 14th. *Admission is free.*
